- **Overview** Working as a web developer for the Eppley Institute, it has been my responsibility to work with other developers and designers to implement the Institute's revamped website.
- **Technical Environment** The Eppley Institute creates and sells e-courses for training and education for individuals and groups who work in parks and public lands. The new website is running on a LAMP server and consists of Magento, Moodle, and Joomla.
- **Responsibilities** My largest responsibility has been making sure these three applications operate seamlessly, with a single log in and similar look and feel based on the design provided.
- **Technologies Used** The new site runs on PHP, Magento using a version of the Zend framework. The front end involves XHTML/CSS along with both jQuery and Prototype Javascript libraries. The NetBeans IDE was used for editing, along with Bazaar version control via SSH.

- **Overview** Responsible for maintaining and implementing a suite of web applications. Worked with Design, Development, and Account Management departments along with some direct customer interaction.
- **Technical Environment** Resite created and maintained a suite of web applications tailored to property management companies, mostly in the multifamily housing industry. Three main products were marketed and sold. A resident portal which allowed residents at a property to pay rent online among other features, a lease application system which converted paper applications to a web form which could in turn be printed out onto a PDF form version of the paper app, and marketing websites, which were websites specifically designed and tailored to the client utilizing much of the data storage from the rest of the system. All three were managed from a control panel accessible to managers and employees of the client company.

- **Responsibilities** As Technology Analyst, my duties varied greatly. On a regular basis I performed data conversion and import of resident information and lease application setup and testing of both for new launches. I was also responsible for setup and support of all email addresses hosted from our servers, employees and customers. In addition, I was assigned programming tasks which were outside the capabilities of the design department, and some bug fixes and feature requests which did not warrant the attention of the development team. Lastly I was responsible for basic tech support for our clients and some of the office staff.
- **Technologies Used** Resite's system ran on LAMP servers, our development was done entirely in PHP and MySQL, using Bazaar revision control. Most tasks required HTML and CSS knowledge to complete, along with some command-line PHP, Javascript, and XML. The design team used Windows XP and the development team used Linux (Ubuntu). I used both, switching to windows when I needed to use Adobe products. Text coding was done in Jedit.
